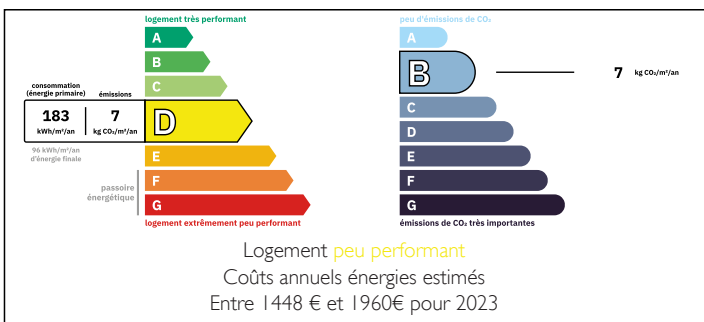

DESCRIPTION

With a great location in the centre of Puissalicon, discover this charming winegrower's house full of original character.

Entering from the ground floor, you'll find an Art Deco-style entrance hall with original tiles. This space provides access to the main living area on the first floor, as well as to the garage/storage area and the self-contained studio.

The studio offers approximately 19m² of living space, including a small kitchenette, shower room with WC, and a bed/seating area. It also benefits from its own private terrace of around 63m², with room for a car and gated access to the road.

The first floor features a bright, open-plan living area with a modern fitted kitchen and island. At the front, a large curved balcony provides a relaxing space with views over the surrounding countryside. This level also includes three bright bedrooms with storage, a separate shower room with sink, a separate WC, and a large storage cupboard.

From the kitchen, a door leads to the rear garden. On the way, you'll find a charming bar/seating area, then stairs take you up to the main garden. Here, you're immediately captivated by the view of the château. This first section features a large covered veranda with built-in seating and a custom-built BBQ.

The garden continues to the in-ground 8.5m x 4m heated saltwater pool, surrounded by sunbathing areas, mature planting, and additional spaces for entertaining. There's also side access to the garden from the road.
