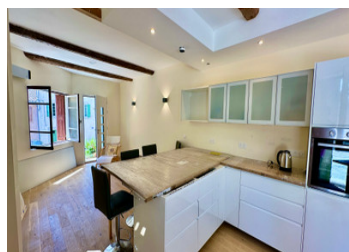

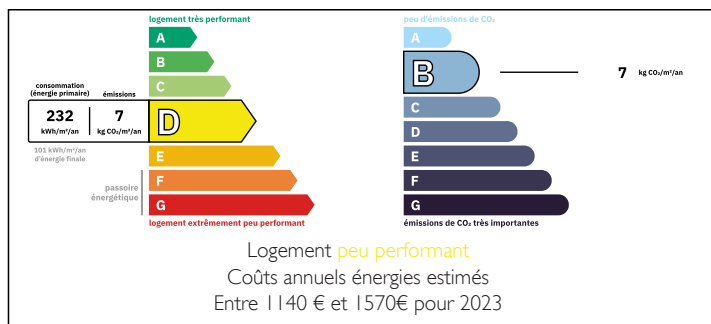
IN BRIEF

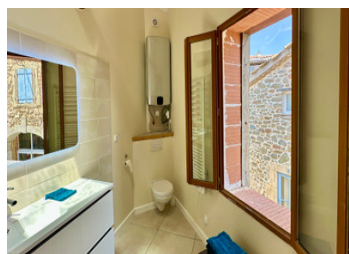

With renovation nearly complete, it's a fantastic opportunity to personalise the final touches and make it truly your own.

Perfectly located near a renowned château and winery, and just minutes from charming local restaurants, galleries, and the pleasures of life along the Canal du Midi, the house is also extremely convenient for day trips: Narbonne is just 25 minutes away, and the Mediterranean coast only 40 minutes.

Even closer are a host of picturesque villages, inviting restaurants, and attractions scattered along the canal. For those who enjoy an active lifestyle, the area is ideal for cycling, hiking, river swimming, and of course, boating on the canal. And for winter enthusiasts, skiing in the Pyrenees is just about two hours away.

- Béziers Airport – 50 minutes
- Perpignan Airport – 60 minutes
- Montpellier Airport – 1 hour 20 minutes
- Toulouse Airport – 1 hour 30 minutes
- Narbonne TGV train station – 28 minutes (with service to Paris in just over 4 hours)
- A9 Autoroute – 25 minutes (main route to Spain and the Pyrenees)
