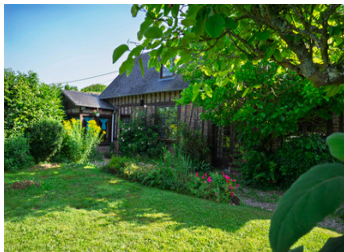


Nestled in a peaceful rural setting, this charming 145 m² Norman house is ready to welcome its new owners.

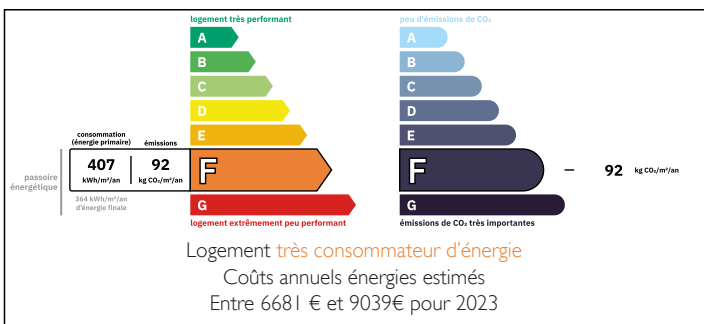

DESCRIPTION
