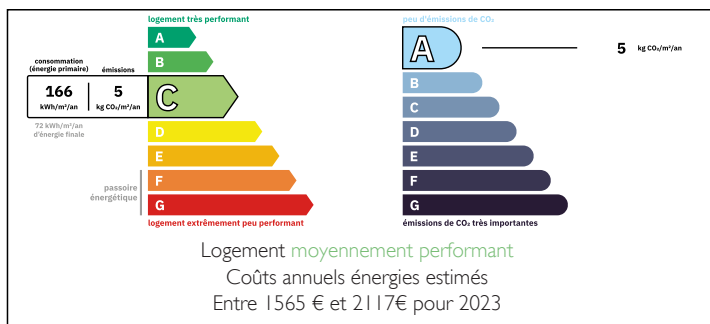
IN BRIEF

A three bedroomed house in stone full of period features. Enter into an open plan sitting, dining, kitchen area (45m2) through french doors. There is a period fireplace with a log burner. There is a cellier off the kitchen (6m2) and a balcony with great views (7m2).

A wooden staircase leads up to the first floor where you find a second sitting room and large stone fireplace (30m2). There is a separate wc (2.25m2) and an ensuite bedroom (13m2) with shower room, sink and toilet (13m2). Another wooden staircase leads to the second floor with 2 more bedrooms of 11m2 and 9m2 in the eves and a bathroom with toilet (3m2).

Outside there is a barn of 130m2, a small barn in the garden of 19m2 a terrace half covered with an outdoor kitchen and countryside views of...

DESCRIPTION

A three bedroomed, Perigourdine house (130m²) in stone full of period features. Enter into an open plan sitting, dining, kitchen (45m²) through french doors. There is a period fireplace with a log burner. Off the open plan kitchen of 6m² you find a balcony (7m²) with great countryside views and a pantry/laundry area 6m².

A wooden staircase leads up to the first floor where you find a second sitting room, currently used as a library and large stone fireplace 30m². There is a separate wc 2.25m² and an ensuite bedroom 13m² with shower room, sink and toilet 13m². Another wooden staircase leads to the second floor with 2 more bedrooms 11m² and 9m² in the eaves and a bathroom with toilet 3m².

Outside, facing the house there is a barn of 130m², which could be converted. There is also a small barn in the garden of 19m² and a terrace half covered with an outdoor kitchen and countryside views 63m². There is a garage for 2 cars with a wine cellar 68m² and a well. Heating is via heat exchange pump and the wood burner plus the house is double glazed.
