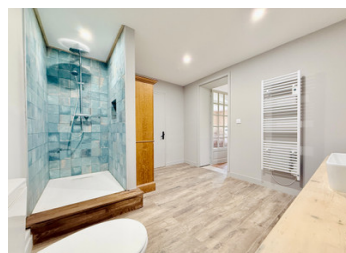

Charming, light-filled stone property, fully renovated throughout, with two large barns in a peaceful rural setting offering spectacular panoramic views.

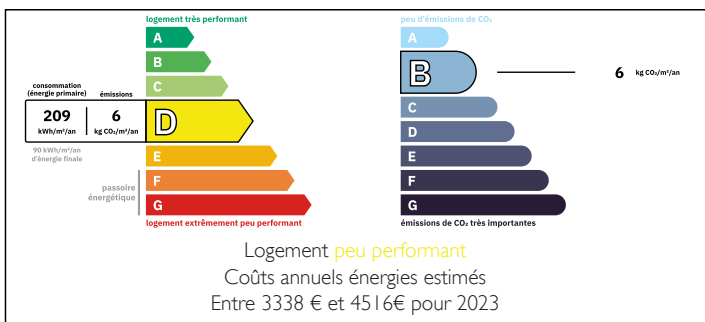

A sweeping driveway leads to the house.

Ground floor:

The spacious, light-filled entrance hall (16 m²) opens onto a large living/dining room (36 m²) with open-plan kitchen (18 m²) overlooking the landscaped garden.

A second cosy living room with wood-burning stove (20 m²) adds charm, while the laundry/utility room (12 m²) has direct garden access.

Two generous bedrooms (21 m² each), both with ensuite bathrooms, and a third large bathroom (18 m²) complete this level.

First floor:

A white-painted wooden staircase leads to two further bedrooms (17 m² and 11 m²).

The entire house is renovated with great taste and style to a very high standard.
