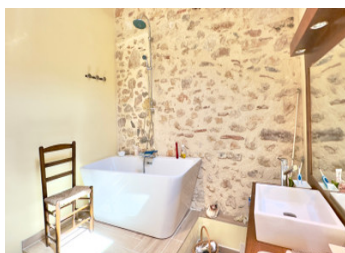

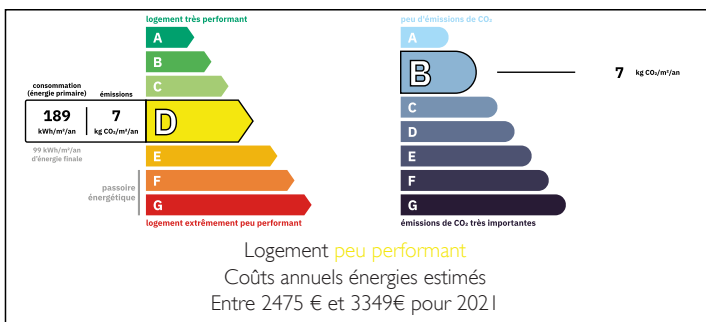

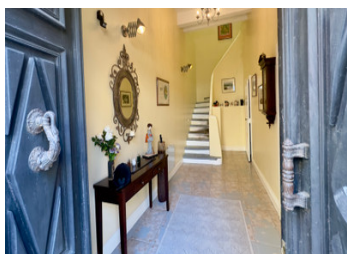

In the heart of the celebrated Saint-Chinian AOP, this beautifully renovated winemaker's house combines the character of a traditional village property with the comfort and style of modern living.

Renovated throughout with great taste, the house retains many of its original features, including exposed stone, traditional construction and characterful architectural details, while offering bright, contemporary living spaces.

The property is arranged over several levels, creating a practical and naturally flowing layout:

- Ground floor: large garage with space for two cars and great storage, plus a WC.
- First floor: spacious open-plan living/dining room and fitted kitchen, with access to the rear of the property and a sunny alleyway.
- Second floor: three bedrooms and a family bathroom.
- Top floor: a superb, spacious bedroom/sitting room with en-suite bathroom, exposed stone wall, beautiful cathedral-style ceiling and exposed beams, together with access to a small private terrace.

The top floor is particularly attractive, offering a flexible space that could work beautifully as a principal bedroom, guest suite, studio or additional living area.

The house is well equipped for year-round living, with double glazing, electric radiators, a wood-burning stove and reversible air conditioning in the main living area. The roof was renewed about 15 years ago.

One of the property's great advantages is its location. From here, you can enjoy the atmosphere and convenience of village life, while the Orb River and its popular swimming spots are nearby. The surrounding countryside, vineyards and hills offer wonderful opportunities for walking, cycling and
