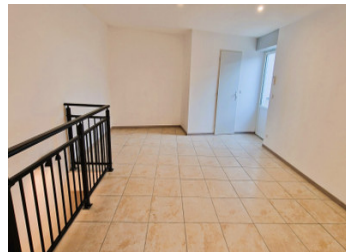


Bright renovated 1-2 bed townhouse in Montpon-Ménéstérol – Ideal rental between Bergerac & Bordeaux

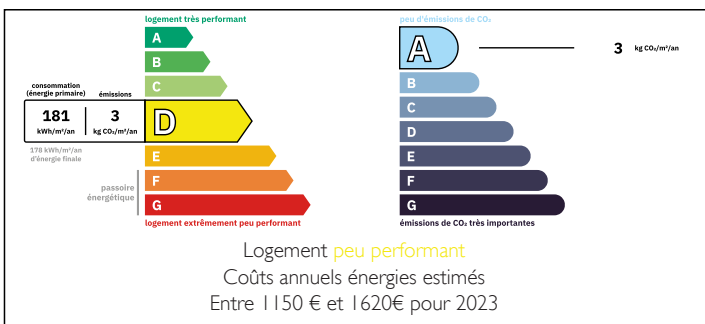
