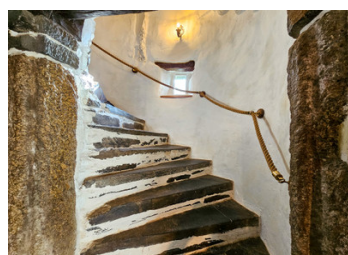

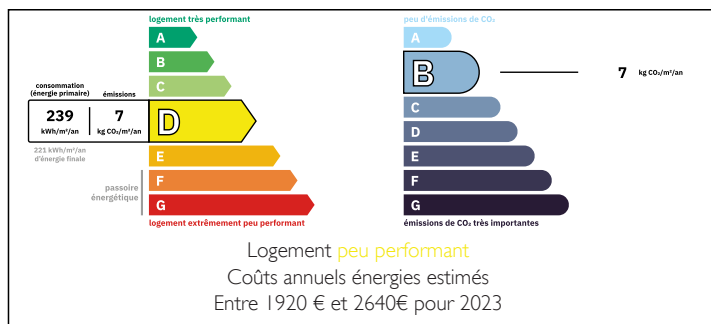

## DESCRIPTION

Previously used as a main house and two holiday gites for additional income, this beautiful group of buildings offer enormous potential. Clustered around an old Breton courtyard at the heart of an ancient village - but within walking distance of the larger village of Gouarec (a popular spot with tourists and cyclists), which has all local facilities and services, including bars/restaurants, shops, a doctors, indoor swimming pool, as well as a railway museum and cycle and boat hire on the scenic river Blavet and Nantes-Brest canal.

### Environment

The current owners have kept the gardens organic, and installed an extensive rainwater collection system which delivers watering directly into the polytunnel, as well as to a garden tap.

The small orchard has a wide variety of fruit trees - figs, apples, pears, plums, cherries and sloes. The gardens also feature a wide variety of native and ornamental trees and shrubs, including an old wisteria, mimosa, magnolias, hydrangeas, rhododendrons, etc...

The central heating and water heating is wood-powered with electric back-up. The water tank is fitted with connections for solar.

The swimming pool is also as environment-friendly as an in-ground concrete pool can be, with fully automatic operation, salt water electrolytic filtration (no added chemicals) and air-source heating - set in a beautiful summer garden.

The surrounding countryside is full of interest. A footpath leads up to the spectacular neolithic monuments - 'allées couvertes' - of the Liscuis - with spectacular views over the Nantes-Brest canal and Daoulas Valley; the...
