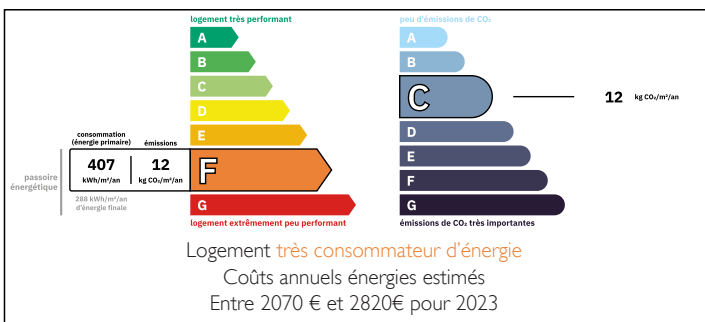
IN BRIEF

Set in a peaceful hamlet surrounded by the beautiful Normandy countryside, this charming stone cottage is full of character and presented to a high standard.

The ground floor offers a welcoming open-plan living space with a fully fitted modern kitchen, plenty of storage, and generous work surfaces. The kitchen opens onto a spacious dining area with room for a family-sized table. A wood burner set in an old stone fireplace creates a warm and inviting focal point, with direct access to the rear sun terrace — beautifully framed by wisteria, perfect for al fresco dining.

The cosy living room features a second fireplace with a wood burner, ideal for relaxing evenings. There is also access to the outbuilding and a downstairs WC.

Upstairs are two bright and well-proportioned bedrooms, each with its own ensuite shower room and WC. Exposed oak beams, high ceilings, and wooden flooring enhance the cottage's authentic charm.

Outside, the property includes a manageable lawned garden, two terraces, a workshop, and a wood shed providing excellent storage or workspace options.

Located less than 2 km from a lively village with all amenities and only 12 km from the medieval town of Domfront with its cobbled streets and château ruins.

The house is double glazed, sold fully furnished, and heated by two wood burners and electric radiators — ready to move into and enjoy.
