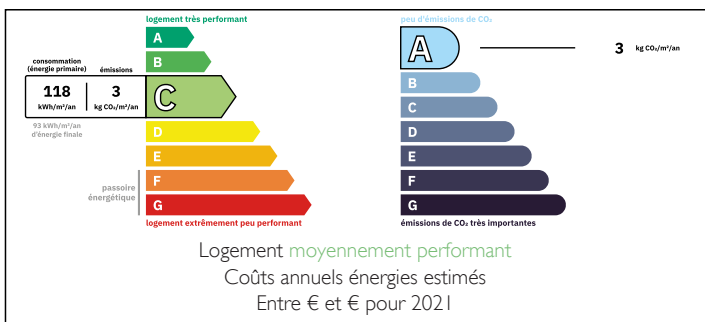

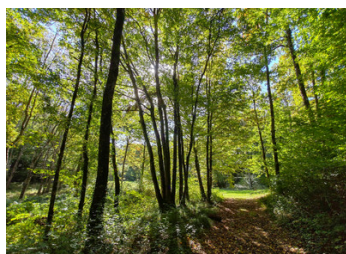

DESCRIPTION

Benefiting from a superb position, boasting the perfect combination of tranquil countryside and easy access to shops and services, this house, whilst providing every comfort inside, is firmly rooted in its surroundings, its trademark ceiling-height fully-glazed doors bringing the best of the outside in and offering each and every bedroom direct access to the garden and woods and meadow beyond.

A generous gravelled drive sweeps around from the road to the understated main door and undercover parking to the rear. Upon entering through the "front" door, you can choose to turn right into a handy utility room (8.7m²) from which a further door leads back out to the undercover parking area, meaning that you can unload the car without having to brave the rain, wind, hot sun or whatever. Back in the entrance hall, a door opposite that to the utility room opens onto the kitchen (6.4m²), which in turn is open to the vast yet cosy main dining/living/stuffy space (48m²) featuring a modern wood-burner and a total of 3 double patio doors, all leading onto the raised terrace and offering spectacular views over the lawn and the woods beyond. Openings to either side of the fireplace lead back to the central hall area (10m² including the part up to the front door) off which is a WC with washbasin (1.7m²) and to your left, the master bedroom (25m²) with en-suite shower room (4m²).
