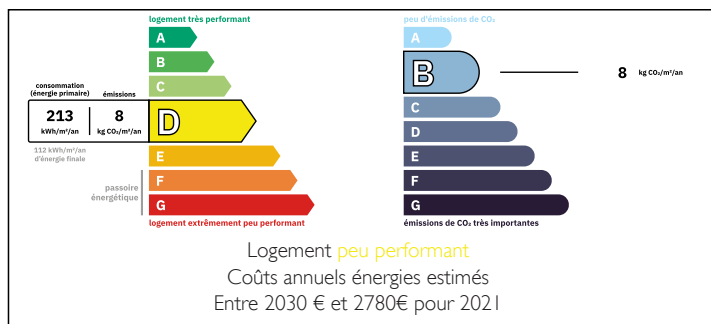
IN BRIEF

The house is divided into two separate dwellings, each with its own private entrance.

The main apartment, set over two floors, features exposed beams, terracotta floor tiles and magnificent views over the river, the old bridge, and the medieval ramparts.

Bright and tastefully decorated, it includes a semi-open kitchen, a cosy living and dining area, and, upstairs, a spacious bedroom with bathroom and WC.

The ground-floor apartment, fully renovated in 2023 in a natural "wood and river" style, offers a new fitted kitchen, a modern shower room, a comfortable living space, and a welcoming bedroom. Perfect as an independent guest suite or a private pied-à-terre for family and friends.

The house benefits from double-glazed windows, electric heating, and two hot-water tanks. Ground floor insulated and double insulation in the attic. The upper apartment is sold fully furnished and decorated.

Across the street, a beautiful landscaped garden invites you to relax. With its outdoor dining area with natural pergola, barbecue, and direct access to the river, it's a true haven of peace, perfect for fishing, canoeing, or simply enjoying a quiet moment by the water.
