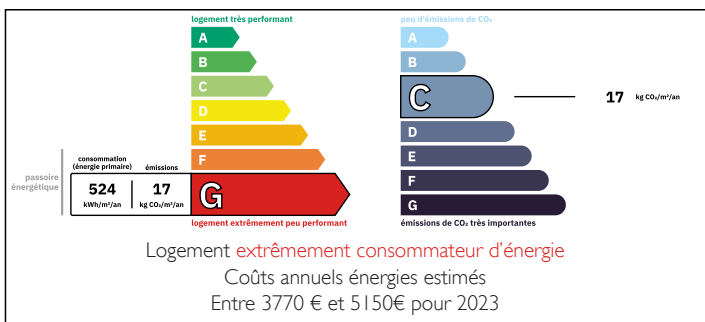
Located only a few minutes drive from the very pretty, vibrant village of Genouillac with 2 bakers, butchers, convenience store, medical centre with doctor, and junior school.
