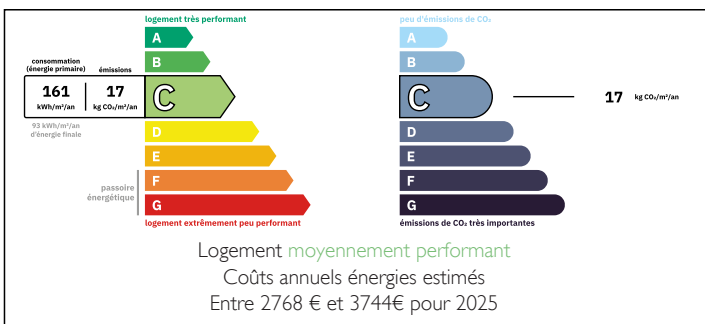

This house, dating from 1647 has many interesting features, such as open beams and a beautiful fireplace. It's to be found in a quiet village in the Green Périgord. Brantôme-en-Périgord is only 15 minutes away with its shops, supermarkets, schools and doctors. There is a primary school in the village and a small shop which serves as post office.

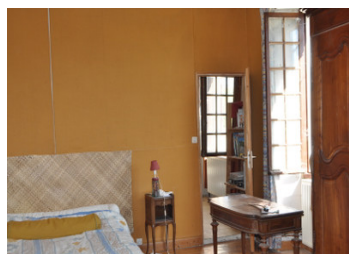

DESCRIPTION

On the ground floor: Large exposed beamed kitchen (30m²) with large fireplace and dark tiled floor. Separate dining room (36m²) with bread oven. This room has an outside door and used to be the village bakery. Lounge with exposed beams (22m²) and staircase leading up to the first floor. French window leading out to small east-facing terrace (7m²). Toilet. Upstairs: Three good-sized bedrooms (24m²; 21m² 20m²), one with fireplace; office area (17m²); bathroom and toilet (7m²), separate shower room (4m²). Well-insulated loft space which could be converted to further living space and pigeon tower. Wine cellar. Energy: heat-pump and solar panels. Oil-fired central heating. Pleasant garden. Garden shed: 21 m².
