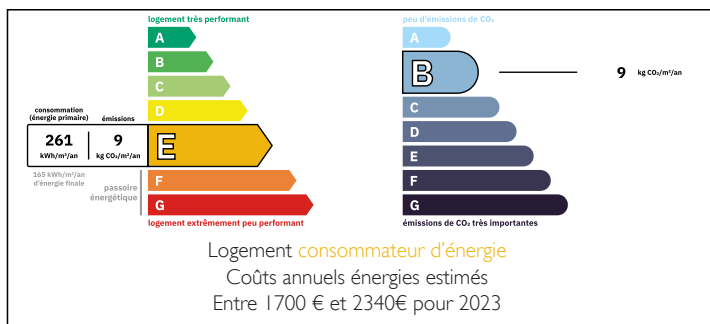

The land is entirely constructable, so an excellent opportunity for an investor, artisan, or multi-generation project with e.g. two dwellings.

Structural and energy upgrades are required (cracks, insulation, heating, windows), but the location, sunshine, tranquillity, and layout of the plot make this a rare opportunity with strong potential for added value once completed.

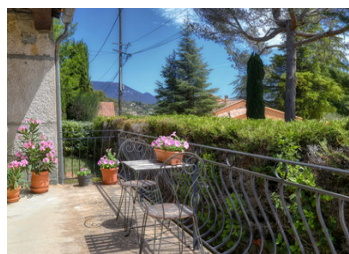
