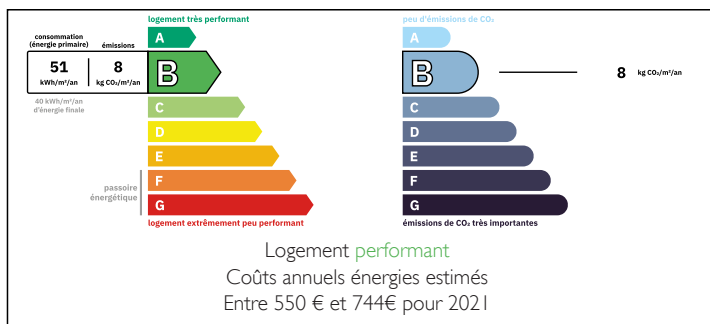


Impressive south-east facing triplex with 3 bedrooms & bunk room. Covered parking – near the centre of Samoëns

The property offers spectacular mountain views and the village centre is just a few minutes walk.

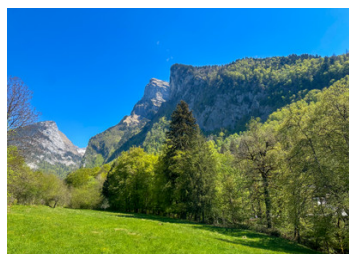
Arranged over three levels, the property features a well-planned layout ideal for a primary or secondary residence. The ground floor features an entrance with a WC and utility room, leading into an open-plan kitchen, dining, and living area with access to a south-east facing balcony.

Upstairs, there is a spacious principal bedroom with its own bathroom, WC, and another south-east facing balcony. The garden level includes multiple sleeping areas—2 bunk-bed rooms, a double bedroom with an adjoining shower room, plus additional bathroom facilities—along with access to a shared garden.

DESCRIPTION

This triplex mid-terrace chalet is located above the Clévieux river which flows through the eastern side of Samoëns before joining the Giffre river.

In a small co-pro, it offers excellent rental potential, with the soothing sound of the river below adding to its charm, and includes access to a shared garden.

While best known for winter sports, Samoëns is a true year-round destination. From late spring to early autumn, the surrounding valley offers an abundance of outdoor adventures—hiking, paragliding, rafting, cycling, canyoning, and swimming in nearby lakes and pools—making it an ideal spot for families and nature lovers alike.

NOTES

In winter, Samoëns provides direct access to France's fourth largest ski domain, the Grand Massif, which links together the resorts of Flaine, Les Carroz, Morillon and Sixt-Fer-à-Cheval. With 265 km of pistes, it's a paradise for skiers and snowboarders of all levels.

Thanks to its proximity to Geneva Airport—only about an hour's drive away—it has excellent accessibility whether you're looking for a permanent home or a holiday retreat.
