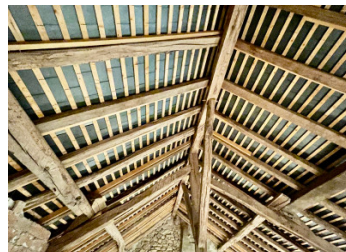


Ancient 17th-century historical house for full interior renovation, with fishing lake and 4 acres of land.

IN BRIEF

Dating back to the 17th century, this characterful property offers a rare opportunity to bring a piece of history back to life. The building is already watertight, with double-glazed windows and doors installed — leaving the rest ready for full renovation to create a bespoke home.

To the rear of the property, a gentle walk leads down to a beautiful 3.5-acre fishing lake, believed to be stocked, though the species remain a mystery. The lake appears on land registry records as far back as 1825, while the house itself is first mentioned in the 1600s — a remarkable testament to its heritage and setting.

DESCRIPTION

The property stands alone on its land, surrounded by established trees and foliage, with the grounds gently sloping down to a picturesque lake.

Inside, the house is currently a shell, comprising a ground floor, first floor, and a majestic attic space, all under a recently renovated roof. Two internal staircases at either end of the property connect the floors.

Ground floor: Three rooms

First floor: corridor and four rooms, plus an ancient toilet room

Second floor: the attic room

All windows have been replaced with double-glazed units and lockable shutters.

The property requires a full renovation, including:

Complete electrical installation

Heating system

Plumbing

Insulation throughout walls and roof

Plaster boarding

Kitchen and bathrooms

Fosse septique installation

The lake does not currently meet regulations, but a new buyer has three years to complete the work. This will include:

Removing trees and overgrowth within and around the lake
