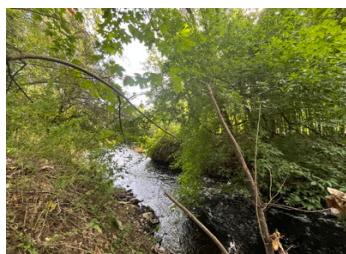

Ancient mill for renovation with a private island - a potential for building up to 9 bedroom riverfront residence on Vienne river, only 6km from historic town of Confolens, with its elementary, middle and high schools, hospital, pharmacies, restaurants, cafes, cinema, markets and all amenities; 68.4 km from the nearest train station in Angouleme, 77 km from Poitiers TGV, 55.6 km from Limoges airport.

DESCRIPTION

The 16th century mill was used up until the 20th century, with later additions to the original 16th Century mill house with race leading from a weir/barrage on a branch of the picturesque river Vienne. It is derelict but still retains the original mill works and is in an exquisite spot nestled in a tiny quiet hamlet of a handful of residences. The land on which it stands embraces the river and weir frontage with a small island which stands in front of the Ile St Madeline and views beyond to the 12th Century Chateau de St Germain de Confolens.

The large building of the mill combines one part on two levels and a second part on three levels. It is this idyllic position that lends itself to the potential development of an outstanding and individual property (subject to the usual consents) and the current owners had drafted plans for a 9 bedroom residence including two potential separate annexed rental properties.

The property is only 6km from historic town of Confolens, with its elementary, middle and high schools, hospital, pharmacies, restaurants, cafes, cinema, markets and all amenities; 68.4 km from the nearest train station in Angouleme, 77 km from Poitiers TGV, 55.6 km from Limoges airport. The area offers endless choices of relaxing walking and biking trails, fishing from the doorsteps of your home or from your private island, and other opportunities to enjoy the pristine beautiful nature.

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
