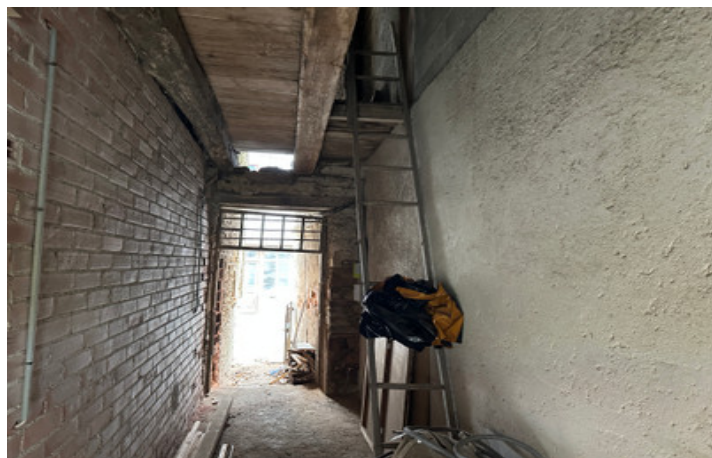

You step into a generous entrance hall that works beautifully as an office corner or a quiet reading space. To the left is a newly fitted shower room with a sink, and just beside it sits a separate WC. From here you move through into a spacious living room of 34.45 m², offering ample room for a lounge, a sitting area and the kitchen, which has recently been upgraded with new units. A cosy log-burning stove sits at the heart of the space, and all windows have been renovated and are now double glazed.

Upstairs is a bright bedroom of 18.3 m², along with access to the attic space of 32 m², giving you the option to create an additional bedroom and ensuite if you wish (subject to the necessary planning permissions).

Outside, the village garden offers a pleasant, manageable space along with a small barn that would make a lovely summer kitchen. The property is connected to mains drainage, water and electricity, and simply needs a few finishing touches before becoming an ideal first home or a charming holiday retreat in the much-loved village of Mialet.
