## IN BRIEF

This property requires renovation but invites creativity. With planning permissions you could run an art gallery, upcycle shop, clothing boutique, or a tea house with accommodation.

Ground floor features dining areas with street frontage, one usable as a workshop and the other as a display space. The kitchen needs updating and a cellar provides storage. A downstairs WC adds convenience.

The first floor houses a dining room, two bedrooms, a bathroom, and a laundry. This could become an owners private apartment with kitchen, lounge and two bedrooms.

The top floor has four bedrooms each with basic plumbing and a hallway WC. Modern electrics updated; glazing is single, with mains water and sewer connected.

## DESCRIPTION

Charming large former restaurant and hotel on Chaillac's centre square offers a rare canvas for a creative project.

This substantial building requires some renovation, but it presents almost limitless potential: an art gallery, upcycle store, clothing shop, or a tea house with upstairs accommodation. With the right planning permissions, you could bring your vision to life and make a unique centrepiece in this lively French town.

### Key features

Ground floor: two generous former dining areas with excellent street frontage for displays or guest entertaining; one space could function as a workshop and the other as a display area.

Kitchen and cellar: kitchen needs refurbishment; a wonderful cellar provides ample storage for beverages and wines.

Convenience: downstairs WC for guests

First floor features a large former dining room, plus two bedrooms, an older-style bathroom, and a laundry room. There is potential here for an apartment: with a quick change of purpose, first floor could become a comfortable private apartment (large lounge, kitchen, bathroom, plus two bedrooms)

Top floor: four bedrooms with basic plumbing (sinks and a bidet) and a single WC on the hallway

Condition and services: single glazing at present; electrics updated in the past; mains town water and sewage connections.

- Clothing boutique
- Tea room with upstairs guest accommodation
- Private residence with a crafts display area
