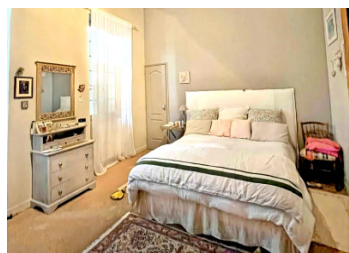


A characterful early 19th-century residence, perfectly restored, located between the beaches and the castle ro

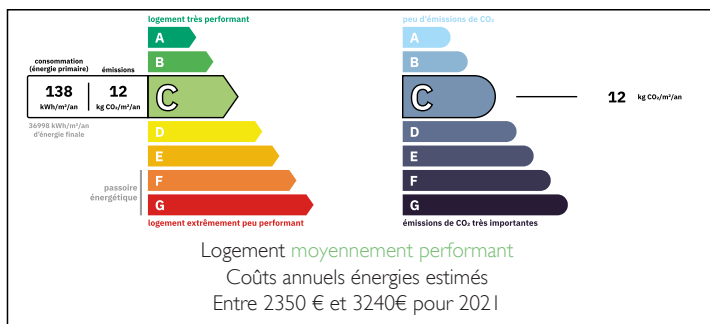
This house is laid out over two levels:

On the ground floor, a lovely entrance hall leads to a 46 sq m living room, a 35 sq m dining room, and a 32 sq m fitted kitchen. A pantry, a toilet, and a separate studio opening onto the garden complete this level.

Upstairs, a large mezzanine landing harmoniously offers a reading room, three beautiful bedrooms, an office, two toilets, and two bathrooms.
