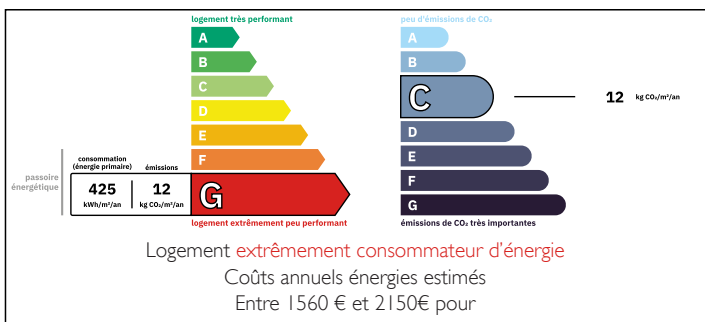

DESCRIPTION

On the edge of a very quiet hamlet in the Bazois, just west of the Morvan Regional Natural Park, lies this authentic village house with a modest garden and a spacious barn. Experience the charm of the Burgundy countryside and make your dream come true. The house is almost entirely in its original state but is habitable. It is the ideal place for a holiday home, especially for those who do not enjoy extensive gardening but still want to fully appreciate the atmosphere and hospitality of the Burgundy region.

Through the entrance gate, you enter the enclosed garden. Access to the house is possible either through the kitchen or via a front door leading to the hallway, which connects to a toilet and bathroom.

From the hallway, you reach the spacious living room with French windows opening to the rear. The living room also provides a passageway to the kitchen.

An external covered staircase leads to the upper floor, where there are 2 large bedrooms. Above this is an unused attic.

Beneath the house is a cellar. In the garden, there is a large barn offering many possibilities for a workshop or studio.
