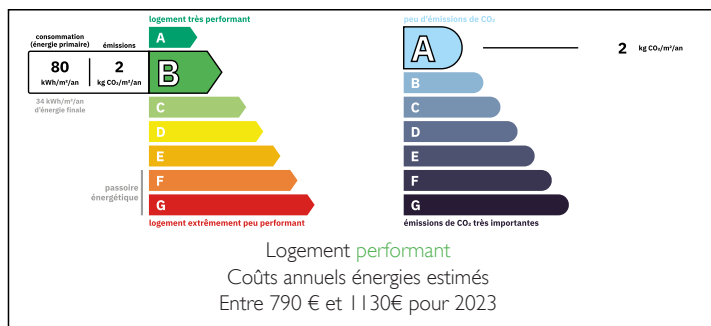

Nestled quietly within its own woodland setting, this exceptional, newly built craftsman cottage feels as though it has been gently shaped by the landscape itself. Set within approximately 5,000 m² of wooded land, the property offers peace, privacy and a deep connection with nature, while showcasing a remarkable level of craftsmanship throughout.

A craftsman-built woodland home

Constructed using a Douglas fir timber-frame structure, the house is full of charm and character. The quality of the woodwork is immediately striking. All interior joinery, including doors, bespoke storage, staircases and the kitchen, has been handmade to measure by a cabinetmaker. These are not decorative elements but integral parts of the structure, giving the home a warm, authentic and timeless atmosphere that is rarely found in modern construction.

Natural light flows through generous openings, highlighting the grain and texture of the wood and creating a constantly changing play of light and shadow throughout the day. The result is an interior that feels serene, grounded and quietly impressive, combining traditional craftsmanship with modern comfort.

The house offers around 140 m² of living space. It is very well insulated, air-conditioned and benefits from an energy performance rating of B, ensuring comfort throughout the year with controlled energy consumption.
