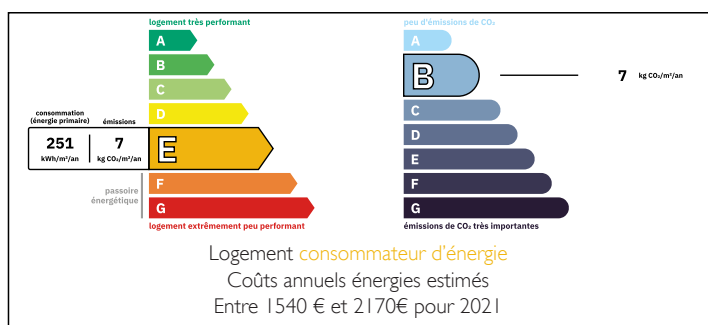

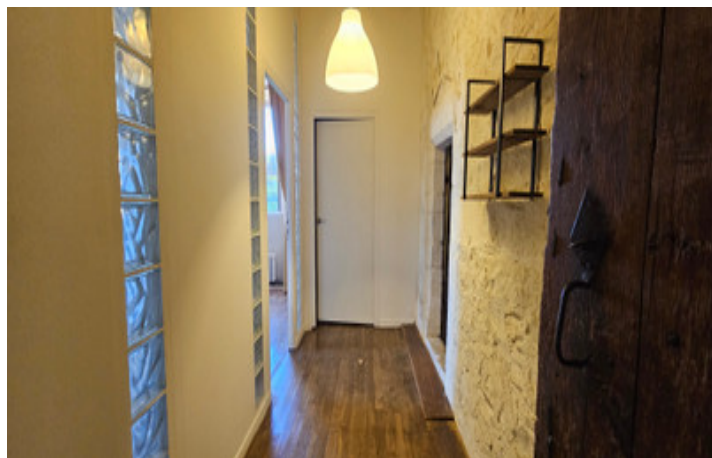

This property, dating back to before 1750 and identified on Cassini's map, is built from limestone rubble typical of the region, combining historic charm with contemporary comfort.
