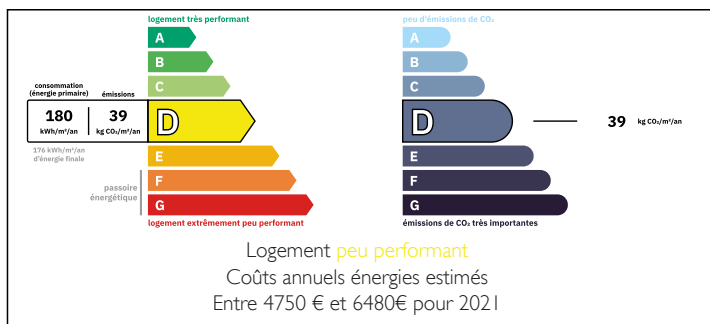
If you are looking for a remarkable property just 10 km from the town of Castres, in the heart of the small town of Labruguière, then this incredible property will be the one for you!

DESCRIPTION

Let us begin the tour. First, impressed by the size and architecture of this building, we push open the imposing and ornate solid wooden door!

We find ourselves in the entrance hall, which leads to a light-filled reception room opening onto the park with its oriental-style wrought iron door. What a room! The warm tones of the cement tiles and wood panelling, the vaults and pillars accentuate the bourgeois character of this residence.

This is the heart of the ground floor. The first wing comprises a cosy, intimate lounge/study, followed by a large lounge with a fireplace and double-height windows, including a French window that opens onto the terrace and south-facing park!

Returning to the reception room, which includes a WC and access to the cellar and its boiler room with gas boiler and wine cellar, we return to the dining room, which benefits from the same features as the large living room described above, with a fireplace, double-height windows and original architectural embellishments!

The kitchen area is located in its extension, a room with original features to be preserved and renovated for an authentic feel.

From this room, a staircase leads to the first floor to a laundry room, toilet and storage area, formerly used by the domestic staff.

The kitchen also opens onto the terrace and its park, near the swimming pool area.

Back in the reception room, we take the staircase, a true work of art where wood and wrought iron blend beautifully. Here we are on the...
