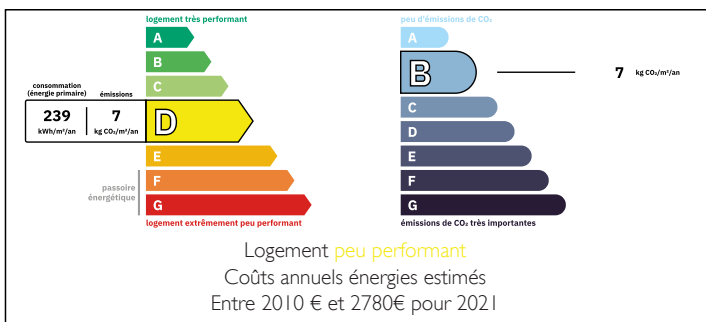

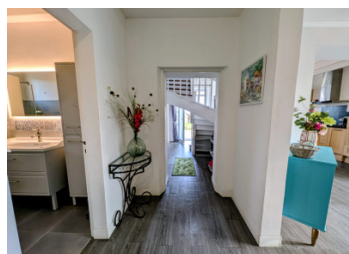

DESCRIPTION

Gondrin is a charming village in the heart of the Gers, known for its relaxed pace of life, traditional stone houses, and welcoming local markets.

The surrounding department of Gers offers rolling countryside, sunflower fields, and picturesque bastide towns that embody the spirit of Gascony.

Visitors can enjoy renowned Armagnac producers, vibrant summer festivals, and a rich culinary heritage featuring duck, foie gras, and local wines.

With its historic churches, scenic walking routes, and authentic rural atmosphere, the area provides a peaceful yet culturally rich escape in southwest France.

Ground Floor

The accommodation comprises an inviting entrance hall, a 13.14 m² bedroom with built-in wardrobe, a fully fitted open-plan kitchen, and a bright and spacious 48.75 m² living room opening onto a south-facing terrace — perfect for outdoor dining and entertaining. A second lounge of 22.70 m² provides additional living space. The ground floor also features a modern 5.10 m² shower room with walk-in shower, a laundry room, and a separate WC. The property benefits from double glazing throughout, electric and manual shutters plus a modern pellet burner with insulated attic space to make it efficient during cooler months.

First Floor

Upstairs, the property offers two further air-conditioned bedrooms (14.62 m² and 15.48 m²) along with a shared WC.

The property is accessed through electric gates and down a sweeping private driveway with ample parking for at least 4 vehicles. The well maintained grounds include a superb masonry swimming pool (14m x 4m), built in 2024, with liner and...
