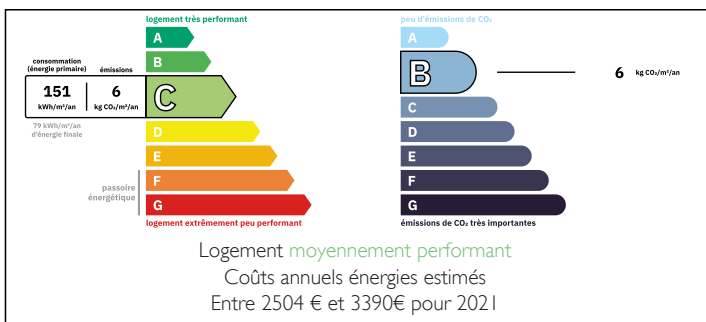
IN BRIEF

From the street, the house presents a traditional village façade, while inside it reveals generous volumes and a warm, welcoming atmosphere. From the moment you enter, the beautiful living area with exposed stone walls sets the tone — a characterful and convivial space where natural light flows easily.

The courtyard of around 15 m² extends the living room both visually and physically, creating a pleasant connection between indoor and outdoor living. This intimate space easily becomes a small outdoor room in its own right, ideal for setting a table, enjoying relaxed outdoor meals or hosting barbecues with friends.

The ground floor also includes a separate kitchen, a bedroom with a full shower room — perfect as a guest suite or home office — and direct access to the garage. Reflecting the house's wine-growing heritage, two former wine vats are currently used for storage, while a third remains unopened and offers further potential.

On the first floor, the sleeping area features two comfortable bedrooms and a bathroom with a large spa-style bathtub. This level also provides access to a private 41 m² terrace, accessible from both the landing and the main bedroom, offering a wonderful outdoor space for relaxing, entertaining, or creating a peaceful lounge area.

The top floor, already insulated and partly converted, includes an additional bedroom, a large studio space of around 27 m², and a shower room ready to be completed, offering further possibilities depending on your needs.
