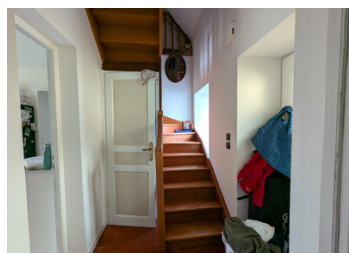

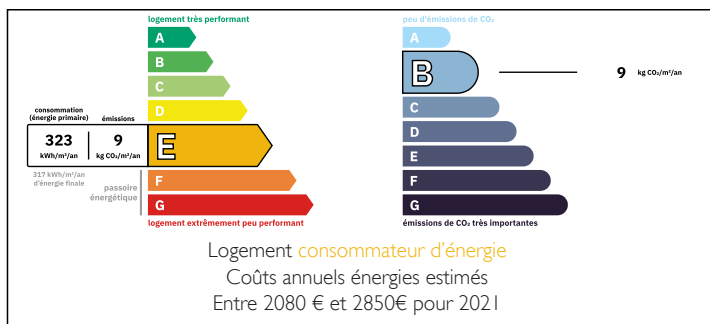

DESCRIPTION

Several entrances lead into the property, where, on the ground floor, you'll find two large reception rooms, a kitchen, hallway and separate toilet. Upstairs, there are two spacious bedrooms – one with a dressing room/office attached – plus a roomy bathroom with bath and shower, and a separate toilet. The property is full of character, with a great fireplace and woodburner, beams and tomette floor tiles.

The cellar extends under the whole of the house, with a sous-sol area containing a recently installed wood pellet boiler for central heating. There is also a thermodynamic hot water tank.

Outside, a raised terrace has spectacular views across the river - the perfect spot to sit. The house benefits from an unusually large plot of land, with grassed areas, walnut trees, and a wonderful orchard of fruit trees.

Nohant-Vic has a school, shops, bars and restaurants. Its church is a listed Historical Monument because of its incredible 12th century frescoes. Further services can be found in the charming small town of La Châtre (5 kms). The city of Châteauroux is only 35 minutes away, where direct trains to Paris take less than 2 hours.

Located in the ancient Berry region, this part of central France is a hidden gem, with châteaux, gardens, vineyards and beautiful countryside waiting to be explored.
