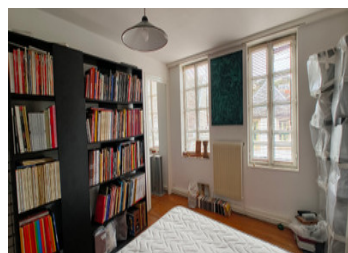
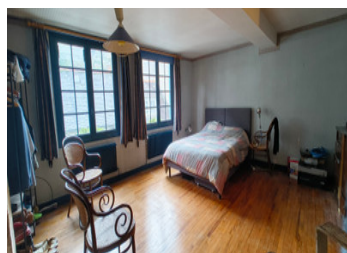


Traditional 17th-century house with Morlaix lantern, in the heart of the historic centre. 5 bedrooms

You will also appreciate the charm of the granite staircase leading to the four upper floors and the Morlaix wooden flooring.

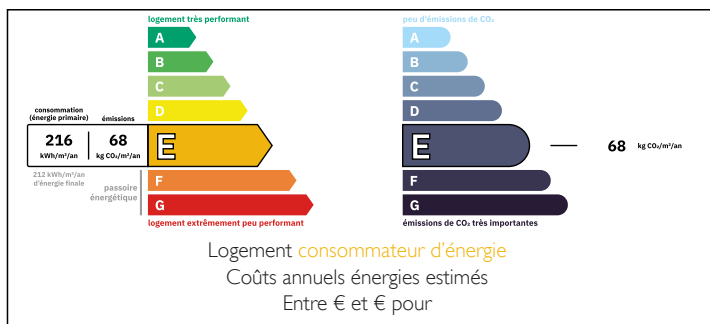

Features:

Wiesmann oil-fired boiler (old), central heating and hot water.

Partially double glazed, mostly single glazed (special financial assistance available from the local authority, historic district)

Insulation could be improved, but the house is sound and has good thermal inertia.

Electrical work to bring up to standard required.

Two beautiful open fireplaces (not currently functional).

One decorative fireplace.

Collective sanitation.

Fibre optic cable installed.

Renovated timber-framed façade.

A magnificent property in Morlaix, the historic weavers' district, in the heart of the town centre with all amenities, very quiet environment, a must-see!
