Set in the heart of the historic bastide town of Villeréal, this medieval townhouse offers an exceptional renovation opportunity within walking distance of excellent local amenities. The property is believed to date from the 13th century and retains Original character features including beams, stonework and fireplaces. The interior is a complete blank canvas, with essential services already connected and scope to create 4-5 bedrooms plus a private courtyard. With strong fibreoptic coverage in the town this is a rare chance to design a bespoke home in one of the region's most desirable villages. Bergerac Airport and train station are a 30 minute drive

DESCRIPTION

Villeréal is known for its beautifully preserved square, lively year-round atmosphere and excellent amenities, all just a short walk from the property. Boulangeries, cafés, restaurants, bars, a supermarket, doctors, pharmacy and vets are all close by, along with the colourful weekly Saturday market and a renowned local pâtisserie.

Believed to date back to the 13th century, the property retains a wealth of original features including exposed beams, stonework and traditional fireplaces. The interior is currently open and undeveloped, electricity and mains drainage are connected.

Ground floor (open plan):

- Kitchen area — 17.3 m²
- Dining area — 30 m²
- Salon — 21.5 m²

First floor:

- Bedroom 1 — 30 m²
- Bedroom 2 — 18 m²
- Bedroom 3 — 22 m²

Attic: 43 m²

The generous attic offers further development potential, and once renovated the property could comfortably accommodate four to five bedrooms, depending on the chosen configuration. To the rear, a small outdoor area can be enclosed to create a private courtyard.
