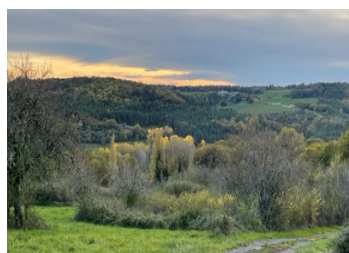


Two houses to be renovated with a barn, 6 acres and a spectacular view in the Perigord Noir

A charming property complex with potential for renovation, set on 2.3 hectares of land, just a stone's throw from Montignac and the Lascaux Caves. Two stone houses (80m² and 90m²), each with three rooms, original fireplaces, vaulted cellars and convertible attic space. A barn of 200m² on 2 levels with exposed beams and a recently replaced roof. Gently sloping land, trees (including a hundred-year-old elm) and unobstructed views facing south-west.

DESCRIPTION

A unique property complex to be revitalised – stunning views, 2.3 hectares of land, a stone's throw from Montignac and the Lascaux Caves.

Set amidst the unspoilt countryside of the Périgord Noir, on the heights of the secluded Laurence Valley, this rare property offers an idyllic setting for a charming holiday home, a venue for events, or a new life in the countryside.

Located less than 10 minutes from the Lascaux Caves and the town of Montignac, with its markets, restaurants and amenities available all year round, the property comprises two traditional Périgord houses, a stone barn, outbuildings and 2.3 hectares of adjoining land, including 3,600m² of buildable land, all forming a small, private hamlet in absolute tranquillity.

Two stone houses (approx. 80m² and 90m²), each with 3 rooms, original fireplaces

including two cantous, vaulted cellars and convertible attic space - A large 200m² barn on two levels, with beautiful timber framing and a recently replaced roof - Outbuildings to be renovated as required - A single, gently sloping plot, wooded (with a hundred-year-old elm) and offering unobstructed

south-west facing views - An ideal setting for a swimming pool, landscaped garden, vegetable patch, small orchard, or relaxation area
