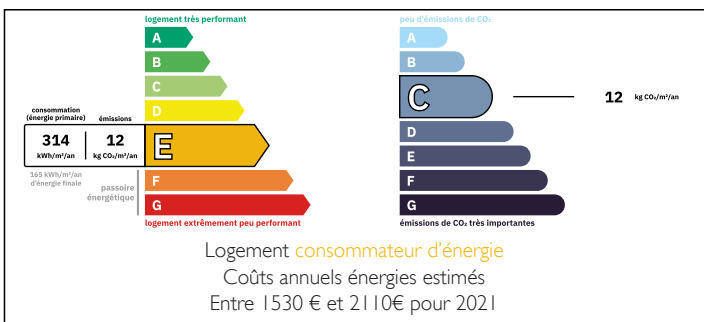

The Apartment....

This spacious 2 bedroom property is located on the third floor of a 4 storey building at the lower end of the Historic Old Town.

There is one other permanent resident in the building, which is set back from the main street and very quiet.

The apartment has 2 large bedrooms and a separate toilet and bathroom, which need refreshing. The main living area includes the open plan kitchen which offers lots of cupboard space.

The property comes with a large 16 m cave on the ground floor which could be renovated to provide an extra living room or workshop.

This property will make an ideal first home or a project for holiday rentals.

The Old Town of Briançon is recognised as UNESCO World Heritage Site and has received great funding over the last 15 years. It is also known as The Citee Vauban, after the great military architect who helped strengthen the fortifications of the town. It is almost self contained, having numerous shops, bars and restaurants as well as a close community of inhabitants who take pride in the unique place that they call home.

There are local bus services that operate from both the top and bottom end of the town, which also pass by the ski lift at Proel.
