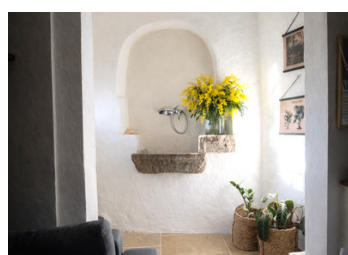
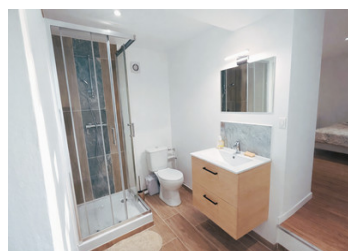
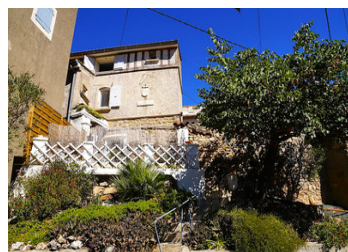


Fully restored hilltop character home with south-facing terrace, jacuzzi, and panoramic views

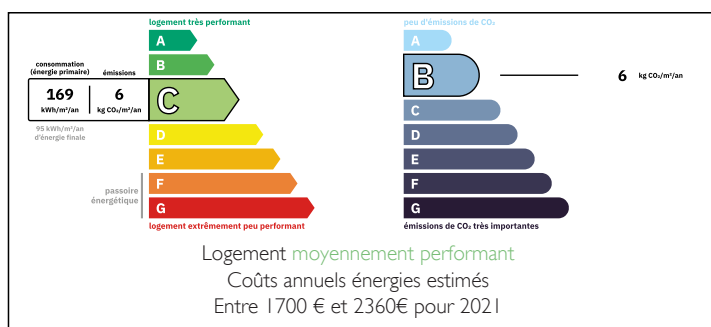
