Charming south-facing stone house set on two separate plots, offering both immediate comfort and development potential.

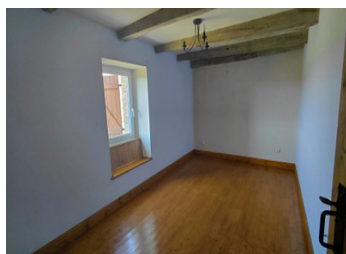
The main house features a spacious living room with fireplace, a kitchen with direct access to the garden, as well as attractive wooden flooring and an original staircase. On the first floor: three bedrooms, a bathroom with WC and a shower room. On the second floor, there is a fourth bedroom, an office (which could be used as a fifth bedroom), and a shower room with WC. Double glazing and shutters are in place, although heating is to be installed.

Outside, the property benefits from a garden, a driveway, and a stone outbuilding currently used as a garage, which could be converted (subject to the necessary permissions).

A second plot includes a large L-shaped building
