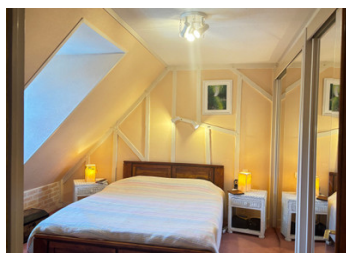

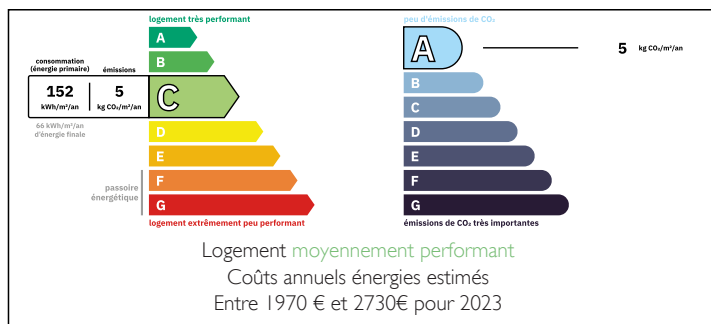

DESCRIPTION

Built in 1991 and lovingly maintained ever since, this impressive 200 m² home sits at the gateway to the charming village of Razac-de-Saussignac, in the heart of one of France's most celebrated wine regions. With both the Dordogne and Gironde departments within easy reach, the town of Sainte-Foy-la-Grande just minutes away, and Bergerac airport only 23 km distant, this property offers a rare balance between rural tranquillity and everyday convenience.

The main house spans three levels and offers eight rooms in total. At its heart, the ground floor is designed for conviviality: the kitchen, dining room, and living room flow seamlessly into one another, perfect for entertaining guests of all ages. Through large glazed doors, you step into a veranda currently fitted as a billiard room, as well as a covered, shaded terrace opening directly onto the pool. A utility room doubling as a secondary kitchen, along with a separate WC, complete this level.

Upstairs, three generous bedrooms and a family bathroom fitted with both a bathtub and a separate shower. A large mezzanine landing is currently used as a home office. At garden level, a large garage and cellar provide excellent storage, alongside an additional room that could serve as an extra bedroom. Heating is provided by a heat pump, hot water by a thermodynamic water heater, and underfloor heating warms the billiard room.

Separate from the main house, the Pigeonnier is a characterful two-star-rated gîte spread across three half-levels. It includes a fully equipped kitchen,...
