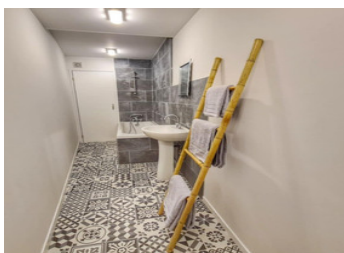

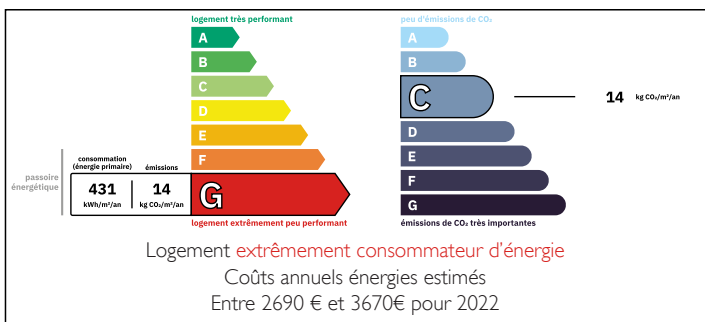

GROUND FLOOR: the front door opens in to the large kitchen dining room. There is a gorgeous typically Creusois stone fireplace, which has been recently fitted with a wood burner. The kitchen has a washing machine, a small electric oven, a hob with 2 burners and 2 fridges. Off the kitchen, is the bathroom and toilet.

FIRST FLOOR: a spacious but cosy, dual aspect living room with access to the balcony.

SECOND FLOOR: Bedroom 1, Bedroom 2, access by trap door to the large attic from Bedroom 2
