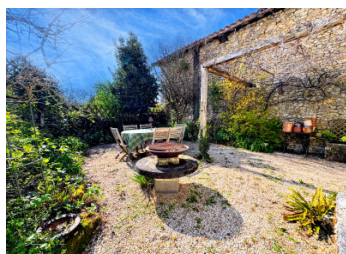
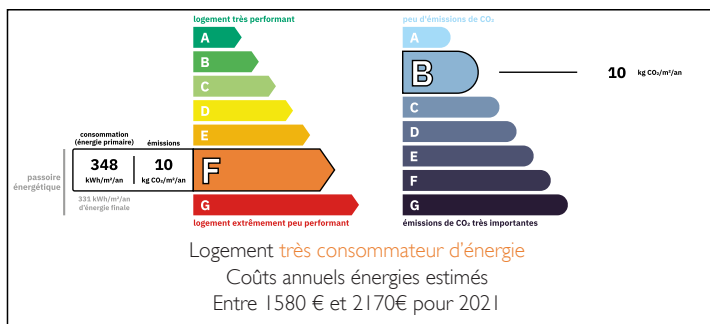

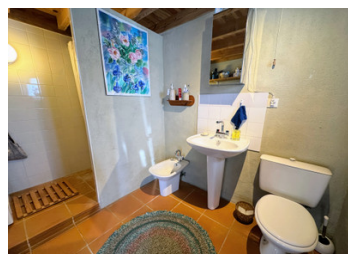

Charming Furnished Barn Conversion – Ideal Low-Maintenance Holiday Home (Converted 1992)

This delightful barn conversion, completed in 1992, offers a characterful and low-maintenance retreat, perfectly suited as a holiday home. The property provides light-filled, airy accommodation with a blend of rustic charm and practical living space.

The heart of the home is an impressive open-plan living area (54m²), featuring stone flooring and exposed natural stone walls that create a warm and inviting atmosphere. A substantial wood-burning stove efficiently heats the space, enhancing its cosy appeal. The adjoining kitchen area is fitted with handcrafted elm units, and includes a cooker with gas hob and fridge.

Large glazed doors flood the living area with natural light and open directly onto a charming courtyard garden and terrace, offering an ideal setting for alfresco dining and enjoying long summer evenings.

The ground floor also benefits from a shower room comprising W.C., bidet, and wash basin, along with a washing machine and heated towel rail.

Upstairs, a mezzanine bedroom (21m²) provides a versatile space incorporating a dressing area and office corner, overlooking the main living space below.

The property further features a spacious main bedroom (25m²) with attractive oak flooring and its own wood-burning stove, adding both comfort and character.

An additional room (24m²) is currently utilised as a workshop and storage area, offering excellent potential for further development or flexible use.

Externally, a separate nearby plot of land includes a garage and a garden planted with a variety of fruit
