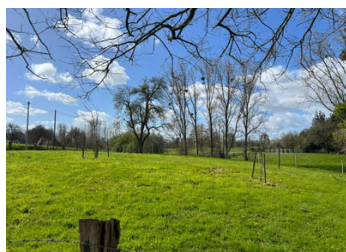

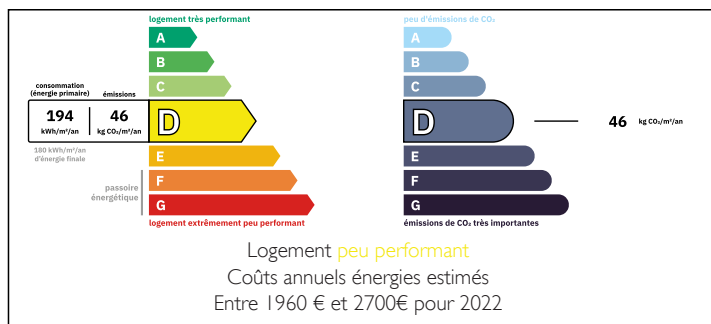

DESCRIPTION

Located off a quiet country lane, this cottage is a beauty.

Ground Floor.

You enter into a spacious double aspect living Kitchen/diner. The kitchen is fitted with solid wood units and there is more than enough space for a dining table and chairs. The living room provides a generous reception room with feature fireplace and wood burning stove. To the rear of the living room leads to the stairs and bathroom of the house.

First Floor.

Wooden stairs lead to two double bedrooms under eaves with generous built-in storage. Flooring is solid wood. There is also a small cupboard, providing useful storage.

The property benefits from gas central heating.

Outside.

The garden is laid mostly to lawn with some mature trees and planting. There is a tiled terrace area to one side of the house and an open lean-to on the other side. There is a good sized wooden shed in the rear garden for additional storage. There are pretty views over rolling country side.
