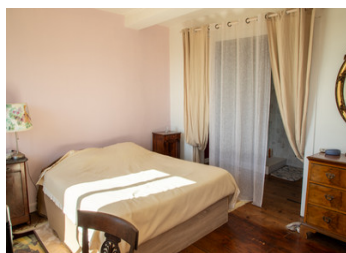


Exceptional 18th-Century Estate – Charming Guest House on the Camino de Santiago with Pyrenees Views

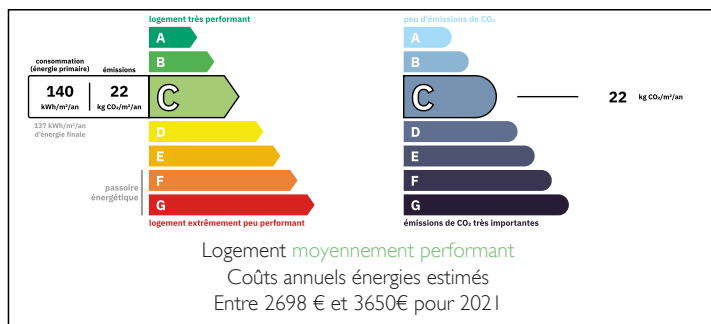

On the ground floor, you will find:

A welcoming double entrance

A large dining room with an open fireplace, ideal for breakfasts and convivial meals

A fully equipped open-plan kitchen with an OLIGER wood stove

A very spacious and comfortable living room, with a few finishing touches remaining

A utility room with a town gas boiler, shower, and WC

Storage space under the staircase

The kitchen and dining room open onto a large south/southwest-facing terrace with views of the Pyrenees.

Upstairs:

A landing leading to three large bedrooms, each with its own private shower room and WC, perfectly suited for guest accommodation

Two hallways allowing easy circulation

A small lounge/office, with the possibility of converting it into an additional bedroom

A second small lounge that could serve as a dressing room, office, or extra bedroom
