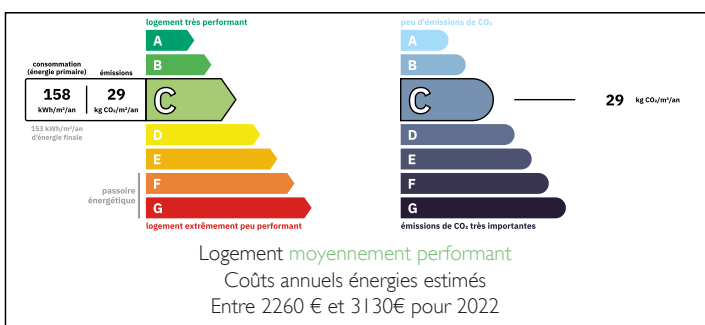

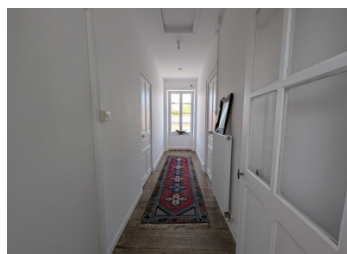

DESCRIPTION

The spacious through kitchen is full of charm with exposed dark beams and a cosy informal dining area ideal for family life. At the end of the kitchen is a practical utility and WC space with sink, heated towel rail and cupboards discreetly housing the washing machine and tumble dryer. Stone steps lead down to the cellar which has been excavated and fitted with drainage and electrics, with glass block windows bringing in light. This space was formerly used as a winery and tasting area.

The lounge and formal dining room offers an elegant yet comfortable entertaining space. Upstairs, the mezzanine provides flexible sleeping accommodation, alongside two double bedrooms including one with beautiful original waxed wooden floorboards, a shower room with Italian-style shower, double sink unit, heated towel rail and VMC system, as well as a spacious parental bedroom.

The house is heated by gas with a De Dietrich remote thermostat. The owners state that the boiler was installed in 2019 with an exterior gas tank. It also benefits from two highly efficient wood burners, one in the kitchen and one in the lounge and dining room. A VMC ventilation system is installed with additional boost ventilation in the kitchen and mezzanine area. Fibre connectivity is available.

Outside, the enclosed garden features several fruit trees including fig, pear and apple. A lovely veranda with shaded overhang creates the perfect setting for outdoor dining, apéritifs and barbecues with family and friends. There is also a prepared...
