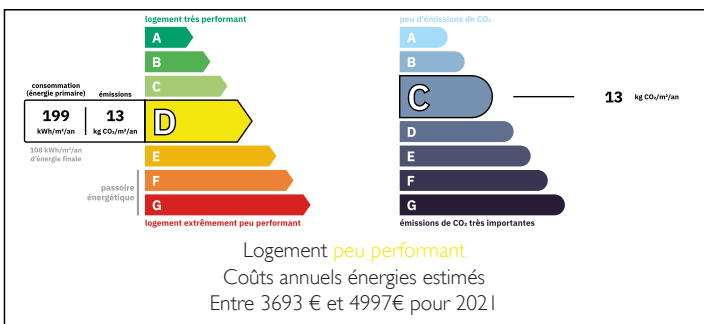

Located in Morsang-sur-Seine, a highly sought-after and tranquil residential village in the south of Essonne, this unique property is less than one hour from Paris, with easy access via the A6 motorway. It provides the perfect balance between countryside serenity and urban convenience—an ideal setting for international buyers seeking authenticity and space while remaining close to the capital.

Built in 1913, this character property is a fine example of the famous “Affolantes” riverside homes from the Belle Époque. Carefully maintained and renovated (including a new roof in 2019), it preserves its original charm while benefiting from modern features such as a heat pump heating system.

The estate consists of a main manor house and a separate caretaker’s house, offering approximately 450 sqm in total, including over 350 sqm of living space and 14 well-distributed rooms.

Upon entering, you are welcomed by a spacious entrance hall with original cement tiles, leading to impressive reception areas filled with natural light. The main living room exceeds 90 sqm and opens onto a terrace with unobstructed views of the Seine. Two elegant lounges and a dining room with a bow window create ideal spaces for entertaining.
