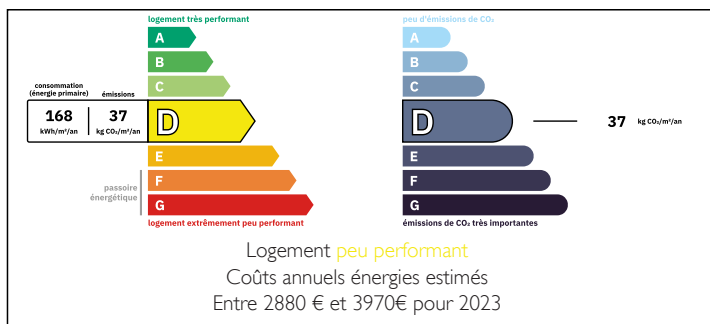

The main house (around 200 m²) is bright and elegant, featuring open-plan living with fireplace, a high-quality kitchen opening onto terraces, 4 bedrooms, office, and generous additional space at garden level including a wine cellar.

Outdoor living is a highlight, with landscaped and low maintenance gardens, a 75 m² covered barn, and a 10 x 5 m pool overlooking the valley. A fully renovated 2-bedroom guest house provides income potential or guest accommodation.

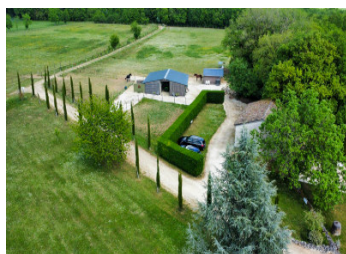
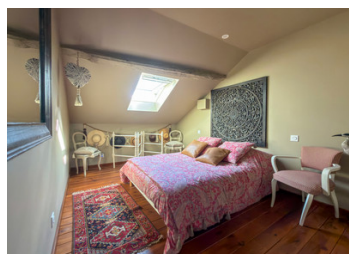

DESCRIPTION

This beautifully presented property offers a deep sense of calm and connection to nature. The atmosphere is one of wellbeing, privacy and gentle seclusion.

The private lane leads into the grounds, immediately creating a sense of arrival. The estate invites you to enjoy a lifestyle shaped by nature: leisurely walks through the grounds, quiet corners for reading, shaded terraces for long lunches, and evenings spent outdoors with guests staying in the independent cottage. The landscape flows gently from garden to paddocks to woodland, encouraging relaxation at every turn.

The landscaped gardens are designed to harmonise with the countryside, offering beauty without demanding intensive maintenance. Several terraces provide spaces for dining, relaxing or entertaining, while the 75 m² covered barn becomes a natural gathering point for summer evenings. The 10 x 5 metre swimming pool enjoys open views across the valley—perfect for quiet morning swims, lazy afternoons with a book, or sunset drinks shared with friends.

Despite its tranquillity, the property remains wonderfully accessible. Agen is just 30 minutes away, offering high-speed rail and road links to Bordeaux and Toulouse (approx. 1 hour) and Paris (around 3 hours). The estate feels like a retreat, yet never remote—ideal for those seeking balance between peaceful countryside living and easy travel.
