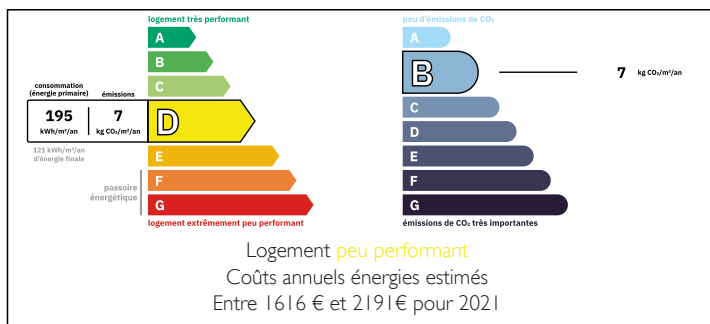


A charming stone farmhouse in a quiet location with no close neighbours, offering mountain views

A TRUE BEAUTY: this 19th-century Provençal stone farmhouse, nestled in the heart of nature just minutes from Bargemon. With no neighbors nearby and boasting a superb unobstructed view, this rare property offers a peaceful setting between the sea and the mountains.

Completely and tastefully renovated, the house has retained all its old-world charm thanks to high-quality materials and unique features. It comprises a spacious living room with an open kitchen and dining area, a second cozy living room, a utility room, two bedrooms (one with a mezzanine), a bathroom with a walk-in shower, and an attic bedroom under the eaves.

Several outbuildings complete the property: a workshop, a small cottage with a jacuzzi, and storage spaces.

Outside, a beautiful terrace of approximately 70 m² with more than 14,000 m² of terraced land planted with oak trees.

Just a few minutes from Bargemon, nestled in an exceptional natural setting, this authentic 19th-century Provençal stone farmhouse will appeal to those who seek authenticity and absolute tranquility. Nestled at an elevation of 500 meters, with no neighbors in sight, the property enjoys an unobstructed and soothing view of the surrounding countryside, set among hills, oak trees, and olive groves.

Completely and carefully renovated in 2012, the house has retained all the charm of the past thanks to high-quality materials and tastefully chosen finishes. Each space reflects the authentic charm of Provençal homes, enhanced by a unique artistic touch that makes this place particularly warm and inspiring.

With approximately 100 m² of living space, complemented by several outbuildings, the home offers a spacious living area featuring an open kitchen, an intimate living room, a utility room, and a laundry room. Upstairs, two beautiful bedrooms, one of which features a mezzanine, share an elegant bathroom. An attic bedroom and a separate workshop provide additional spaces full of character.
