DESCRIPTION

Step into the charm of southern France with this elegant Maison de Maître of 214 m², built in 1887 and beautifully preserved. Located in the vibrant town of Quillan, this home combines original character with modern comfort, offering the perfect base for family life, entertaining, or a second home in the sun.

Light-filled living spaces open onto a wraparound balcony (25 m²), ideal for morning coffee in the sunshine or evening apéritifs beneath the plane trees. To the rear, a private garden of 180 m² with mountain views creates a peaceful retreat for outdoor dining, gardening, or simply relaxing.

The house features five bedrooms (14–20 m² each), plus a large 18 m² flexible room currently used as a workspace — perfect as a sixth bedroom, office, or extra living room. A bright 16 m² kitchen with 5 m² pantry, a 32 m² salon with wood-burning stove, and a 6 m² dressing room upstairs add both charm and practicality.

There are three bathrooms with Wc:

- Ground floor shower room with toilet
- Upstairs bathroom with bath and toilet
- Second upstairs bathroom with bath, shower and toilet

Comfort is assured with two wood-burning stoves plus electric heaters in four bedrooms and two bathrooms. The property is connected to mains drainage (no septic tank) for ease of maintenance.

The layout offers:

- Ground floor: garage + 60 m² of cellars (storage, workshop, or creative use) with direct street access and off-street parking
- First floor: main living areas, balcony, garden access
- Second floor: five bedrooms,...
