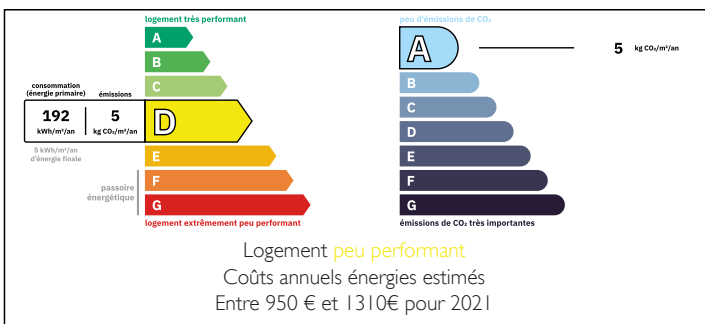


## Renovated mountain hamlet house

## DESCRIPTION

The house is arranged as follows: on the ground floor, you enter into a 23.85 m<sup>2</sup> kitchen leading to a 14.50 m<sup>2</sup> utility/laundry room and a split-level cellar of 20 m<sup>2</sup> with low ceiling height. On the first floor is a lovely sitting room of almost 26 m<sup>2</sup>; this level also includes the bathroom, a separate toilet, and a 14.3 m<sup>2</sup> bedroom. Finally, on the second floor, there is a large 24 m<sup>2</sup> bedroom along with an alcove providing additional sleeping space.

The outbuilding of around 30 m<sup>2</sup> opposite the house deserves to be converted to create additional living accommodation.

It is also worth noting that the property benefits from parking space for two vehicles, which is relatively rare in the hamlet.

The location is excellent. Without being too far from Foix, the property enjoys a preserved setting surrounded by woodland. The village has a school, making it suitable for young families. Those looking for a second home will appreciate the peace and...
