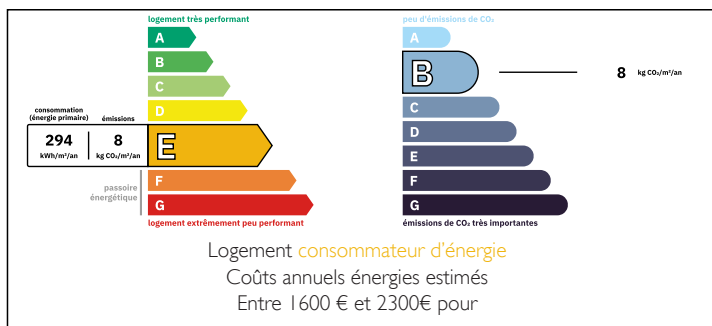

DESCRIPTION

In the rolling countryside of Maillet, in the northern part of the Auvergne region, this remarkable equestrian estate benefits from a tranquil and unspoilt setting with sweeping panoramic views over the surrounding landscape. The area is appreciated for its natural beauty, open countryside, forests and peaceful rural lifestyle, while remaining easily accessible thanks to the nearby A71 motorway connecting Paris and central France.

The property extends over approximately 19 hectares of pastureland, with the possibility to acquire an additional 18 hectares, offering extensive space for equestrian activities, breeding or agricultural projects. The estate is already fully equipped and immediately operational, making it an ideal opportunity for professional equestrian use, a countryside retreat, tourism accommodation or an agrotourism venture.

Equestrian Facilities

The equestrian infrastructure has been thoughtfully arranged to support both leisure and professional activities and includes:

- Main stable of approximately 165 m² with 5 boxes, including 2 broodmare boxes
- Insemination laboratory and ultrasound bar
- Second stable of approximately 70 m² with 5 boxes and 2 independent boxes
- Outdoor paddock measuring 35 x 25 metres
- Pastures with animal shelters
