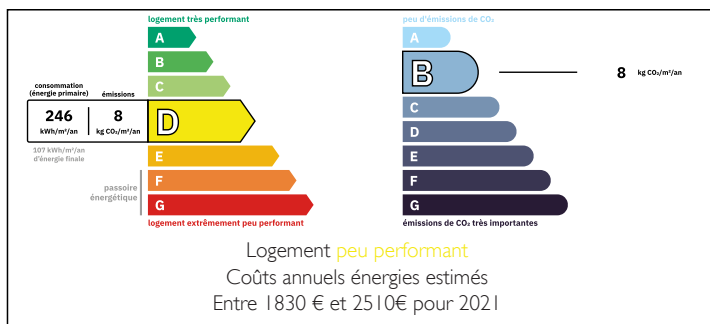

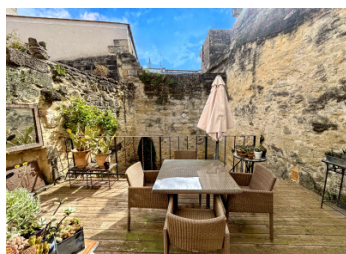
Easy access within 35 km from Avignon with TGV station served by Eurostar trains, 25 km from Nîmes or 83 km from Montpellier with connections to the airports.
