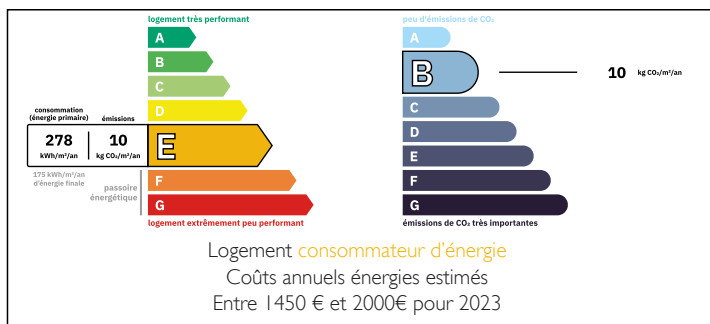

The property offers approximately 69 m<sup>2</sup> of habitable space, thoughtfully arranged to create a warm and inviting atmosphere.

Covered terrace (16 m<sup>2</sup>) designed with two open "frames" that perfectly capture the surrounding landscape—one overlooking the countryside, the other the lush garden filled with flowers and greenery

Galley-kitchen (7 m<sup>2</sup>) well equipped

Living room (15,4 m<sup>2</sup>) with wood burner, with exterior door to a tucked-away nook (7 m<sup>2</sup>) offering the ideal spot to enjoy sunrise coffee or a glass of wine at sunset.
