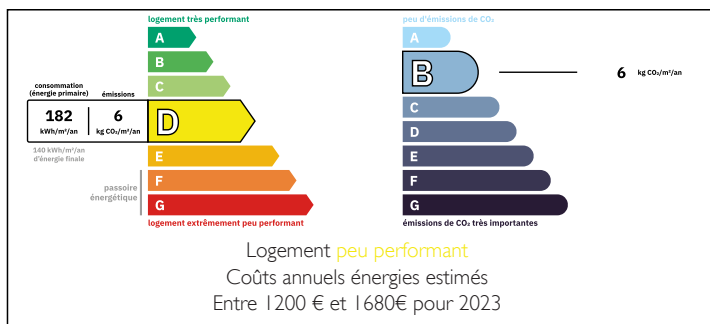

DESCRIPTION

Spacious and light village house south facing courtyard seating area and outbuilding .

The house can be accessed from a small lane to the back of the property directly to the small barn and courtyard or from the main street.

The Rooms - Ground Floor

Entrance Hall (7 m²) with tiled floor and original staircase

Sitting Room (15.15 m²)

Kitchen Dining Room (23 m²) with terracotta floor, door leading to outside courtyard and stone outbuilding

Bathroom/Utility Room (8.35 m²) recently refurbished with travertine and underfloor heating. Bath, shower, handbasin and toilet.

First Floor (Original wooden floor boards)

Bedroom 1 (22.50 m²) with toilet and handbasin

Bedroom 2 (19 m²) with door leading to stairs up to attic

Courtyard - outside seating area (10 m²)

Small barn with mezzanine storage area (13 m²)
