Set in a peaceful and private location with uninterrupted countryside views, the property enjoys a truly tranquil setting.

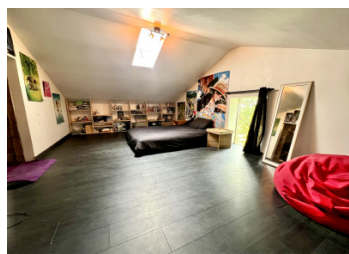

DESCRIPTION

Entry is via a charming terrace that overlooks the surrounding landscape, leading directly into the kitchen and lounge area. A beautiful stone chimney breast provides the perfect focal point for a future wood-burning stove. The exposed stone walls and floor tiles create an authentic and characterful atmosphere. Original tomette tiles bring you into the spacious bathroom/utility room.

Currently, a ladder provides access from the bathroom to the loft area above, offering exciting possibilities for increasing the habitable space, subject to any necessary permissions.

On the opposite side of the kitchen, an opening leads into what is planned to become the future living room, with provisions already envisaged for a pellet stove and an additional opening to the front of the house.

A curved staircase leads to the first floor, where the generous principal bedroom remains in its rustic state, ready for completion. The second bedroom has already been finished and enjoys lovely views across the surrounding countryside.

Outside, there is a former barn, now in a dilapidated condition, which houses the non-compliant septic tank. This sits on a parcel of land that benefits from being constructible. In addition, an adjoining field has recently been acquired and could potentially provide the opportunity for a second dwelling with its own private garden, subject to the necessary permissions.

The orchard is a particular feature of the property, offering an abundance of fruit trees including plum, pear, cherry, peach, persimmon, fig, apple and medlar.
