A farmhouse residence featuring two levels of 110 m² (1,184 sq ft) each, plus an additional open-plan attic level beneath the roof structure. The roof is brand new and equipped with 9 kW photovoltaic solar panels, generating over €3,000 in annual income through an EDF feed-in contract.

An adjoining cowshed and barn attached to the farmhouse.

A large double hangar/barn offering extensive storage or conversion possibilities.

A traditional stone building comprising two cowsheds and a barn.

A workshop with a traditional bread oven.

The property retains all the charm of a traditional rural estate, with generous volumes, beautiful stone buildings, and a peaceful setting in the heart of a hamlet.
